

ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

I-15 Bridge Repairs Begin June 3 through Roy/Clearfield Area
Roy 5600 S. Ramps Closed June 4-7



Construction Overview

Beginning June 3 and continuing for approximately four weekends, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will complete maintenance work on the following I-15 bridges:

- Roy 5600 South Interchange
- Bridge over the Union Pacific railroad tracks (just south of 5600 South) in Roy
- Clearfield 700 South Interchange

To accommodate the work, all I-15 interchange ramps at 5600 South in Roy (Exit 338) will be closed from 7 p.m. on Friday, June 4 to 6 a.m. on Monday, June 7. As alternate routes, motorists may use Riverdale Road (Exit 339), 31st Street (Exit 341) in Ogden or 650 North (Exit 335) in Clearfield. Traffic will be detoured to S.R. 126 (1900 West in Roy, Main St. in Clearfield).

To minimize impacts to the public, most of the work and traffic impacts will be on weekends during daytime and nighttime hours.

For the first two Thursday nights (June 3 and 10), I-15 will be restricted to two lanes at 7 p.m. and one lane from 9 p.m. (Thursday) to 6 a.m. on Friday.

Motorists should expect lane restrictions in both directions on I-15, beginning at 7 p.m. each Friday and continuing through Monday mornings at 5 a.m. for southbound traffic and 6 a.m. for northbound traffic. All freeway lanes will be open outside these timeframes.

East-west traffic on 5600 South and 700 South will be maintained under the freeway bridges.

Motorists should expect travel delays and are advised to use alternate routes. Residents and businesses near the bridges should expect construction noise and vibrations as the work is completed. Motorists should expect lane shifts and are advised to reduce speeds through the work zone.
