## Message from your Fire Department

Here are some guidelines regarding camping and recreational fires.

Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

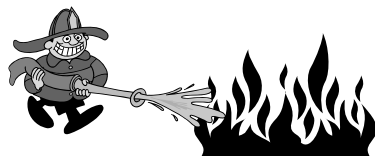
Open burning recreational fires shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum of a 4-A rating or other approved onsite fire equipment such as dirt, sand, garden hose, or water barrel will be available for immediate utilization.

Fires must not be larger than 3 feet in diameter.

Burning of any material other than firewood, briquettes and propane is prohibited.

No burning is allowed on red burn days and/or clearing index under 500.

Roy City Fire Department reserves the right to have the fire extinguished at any time.



## Permissible Recreational Fires

When not prohibited by other laws, or by other officials having jurisdiction and provided that a nuisance is not created, the following types of open burning are permissible without securing a permit according to Utah Administrative Code R307-202-6.

In devices for the primary purpose of preparing food such as outdoor grills and fireplaces.



Campfires and fires used solely for recreational purposes where such fires are under control.

In indoor fireplaces and residential solid fuel burning devices.

## Non – Permissible Burning

Burning of waste material prohibited.

No burning of accelerants such as gasoline, kerosene or other petroleum is allowed.

No burning of any material which may cause severe air pollution.

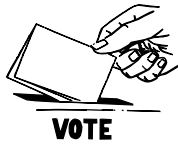

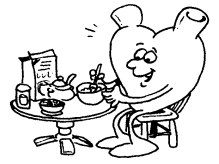

## Air Force Offers Air Sampling In Roy

---

Hill Air Force Base will soon begin contacting homes and businesses near areas of groundwater contamination coming from the base, to notify them that potentially harmful chemical vapors from the groundwater could be entering their homes or workplaces.

Those in the affected areas will receive a certified letter from the Air Force explaining the issue and providing instructions on how to have the air inside the home or business tested. Tests will begin in October and go through March of 2018. If vapors are found above established action levels, the Air Force will take steps to prevent those vapors from entering the home or building. The drinking water has not been affected by the contamination.

The Air Force has been testing the air inside homes around Hill since 2003. As always, the testing is free, as are any future mitigation efforts. If you do not receive a certified letter, your home or business is not within an area of concern.
